


ORDER DENYING MOTION TO DISMISS  
ALL CLAIMS BUT ONE FOR LACK OF JURISDICTION




IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that defendant's motion to dismiss all claims but one for lack of jurisdiction be, and the same is hereby, denied.
