IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiffs' motion for leave to amend the Amended Petition in Docket 74-B be, and the same is hereby, granted.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs' motion for clarification be, and the same is hereby, denied.
