ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR REHEARING AND AMENDMENT
OF FINDINGS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

On March 28, 1972, the majority of this Commission issued their decision in this proceeding, deciding the political structure of the Potawatomi Indians at the times when the United States negotiated the various treaties with them giving rise to the claims asserted in these dockets (27 Ind. Cl. Comm. 187). Two of the Commissioners dissented on the same date (27 Ind. Cl. Comm. 328).

On July 7, 1972, the Citizen Band of Potawatomi Indians of Oklahoma, et al., and the Pottawatomie Tribe of Indians, the Prairie Band of Pottawatomie Indians, et al., filed a Motion for Rehearing and Amendment of Findings. The Hannahville Indian Community, et al., responded on August 16, 1972, and the movants replied on September 11, 1972.

On September 29, 1972, the same movants moved to supplement the record. The Hannahville plaintiffs responded on October 13, 1972, and the movants replied on October 20, 1972.

Having considered the motions, responses, and replies, and being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that the above motions be, and the same are hereby, denied.
