UPON CONSIDERATION of the respective petitions, filed by counsel for the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma, et al., and the Miami Tribe of Indiana, which request the allowance of attorneys' fees; the motion filed in Docket No. 253 seeking a Commission proceeding to determine the proper allocation of attorneys' fees herein; the response thereto from counsel in Docket No. 131; and the decision in Godfroy v. United States, App. No. 8-71 (Ct. Cl., Oct. 13, 1972), and for the reasons set forth in the opinion this day entered herein,


IT IS ORDERED that the motion, filed by plaintiff's attorney in Docket No. 253, requesting a proceeding on allowance of attorneys' fees be granted.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for both the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma, et al., and the Miami Indians of Indiana do the following:


1. File on or before February 23, 1973, written evidence relating to the allocation of attorneys' fees in consolidated Docket Nos. 131 and 253;
2. Submit, within 30 days thereafter, their proposals as to the allocation of fees and proposed findings of fact and briefs in support thereof; and

3. Reply, within an additional 30 days, to the adversary proposals.


