ORDER REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION AND DENYING
DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS EXCEPTIONS NO. 8 AND 9

UPON the opinion this day filed herein and which is hereby made a part of this order,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendant shall have 60 days to determine whether it has held any of plaintiffs' tribal funds in Individual Indian Monies (IIM), or other, accounts upon which interest was credited but not reported or for which interest was not credited, and if there are such funds, an accounting be submitted, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs' requests numbered 1(a) through (f) for further information, in its statement making more definite exceptions No. 8 and 9, be, and hereby are, denied.

IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED that defendant's motion to dismiss exceptions No. 8 and 9 be denied.
