FINAL AWARD

Pursuant to a stipulation of settlement and motion for entry of final judgment filed by the parties jointly herein on June 1, 1976, the Commission, after a hearing held June 28, 1976, having considered the record as a whole, and having this day entered additional findings of fact which are made a part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the proposed settlement of the case is equitable and just to both parties and that final judgment should be entered in accordance with the stipulation.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the stipulation of settlement and for entry of final judgment is hereby accepted, that the joint motion for entry of final award is hereby granted, and that the plaintiff shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) subject to the terms and provisions set forth in the stipulation of settlement and for entry of final judgment.
