ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

UPON CONSIDERATION of the application for attorneys' fee filed herein on June 10, 1976, by Paul M. Niebell, attorney of record for the plaintiffs in Docket 151, Charles Bragman, attorney of record for the plaintiffs in Docket 73, Effie Knowles, Roy L. Struble and the Estate of Roy St. Lewis (by Paul M. Niebell under power of attorney from Paula D. Greenhouse, Executrix), and in accordance with the findings of fact entered herewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the contract attorneys in the above-captioned dockets, Paul M. Niebell, the Estate of Roy St. Lewis, Charles Bragman, Effie Knowles and Roy L. Struble, be awarded as attorneys' fee for all services rendered by said contract attorneys in these consolidated dockets, the amount of \$1,600,000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that out of the funds appropriated pursuant to Public Law 94-303, June 1, 1976, to pay the final award entered in these consolidated dockets on April 27, 1976, in favor of the plaintiffs, there shall be disbursed jointly to Paul M. Niebell, attorney of record in Docket 151, and Charles Bragman, attorney of record in Docket 73, on behalf of the contract attorneys, the amount of \$1,600,000, which represents ten percent (10%) of the final award, for distribution by them to all contract attorneys and their representatives in accordance with the respective interests of each. This amount represents payment in full for all services rendered in the prosecution of the claims in these consolidated dockets.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the objection, in part, to application for allowance of attorney fee, filed herein on June 25, 1976, by Guy Martin, be,

and the same hereby is, dismissed, and, further, that the application for allowance of attorney fee, filed in Docket 73 on June 25, 1976, by Guy Martin, and the motion for separate order in re award of attorney fee, filed herein by Paul M. Niebell on August 25, 1976, be, and the same hereby are, dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion of Guy Martin for leave to file reply in opposition, filed on October 27, 1976, be, and the same hereby is, granted, said reply having previously been filed on September 28, 1976.


